The Rules Of Country Of Origin Representations

- the goods must have been substantially transformed in Australia
- 50% or more of the total cost of producing or manufacturing the goods occurred in Australia.
- all of the processes involved with production or manufacturing happened in Australia.

How Are The Costs Of Australian Made Goods Calculated?

The general rule for a person to meet the Australian made claim for a good or product, is that 50% or more of the total costs must be attributable to the country in which the goods or product has been manufactured.

Costs of shipping goods to Australia may also be included as part of the Australian cost component, along with any insurance and port clearance costs.
